WOOSTER STREETScape ART CONTEST RULES

1. Contest Organizers:

This Art Competition (the “Contest”) is presented by the Wayne Center for the Arts and Main Street Wooster, Inc. (both 501(c)(3) non-profit organizations) in cooperation with the City of Wooster and Artfind Tile (collectively, the “Organizers”).

2. Theme = Life in Wooster:

This is a broad concept theme. A piece qualifies as long as people won’t scratch their heads and say, “What on earth does this have to do with Wooster?” *Examples:* Native plants, native animals, local sports teams, industry, civic groups, arts, culture, landmarks.

3. Mood = Uplifting:

Examples: beautiful imagery, positive family scenes, cooperative effort. Images may not include content which is offensive, violent, discriminatory, derogatory, sexually suggestive, obscene, defamatory, or contains explicit language or imagery or is otherwise unlawful or inappropriate for public display. All decisions regarding appropriateness of an Entry are at the sole discretion of the Organizers.

4. Color Palette = Earth Tones:

No neon or fluorescent colors. Each piece or series of pieces will be printed with a ½” sepia border to visually separate it from adjacent art.

5. Finished Size / Format:

Finished art must be sized at or reduceable to twelve inches square.

- Digital art must be at least 300 dpi at actual size (12” x 12”) saved as eps/jpg/tif.
- Two-dimensional works of art must be capable of being transported off-site to be scanned to a 12” x 12” finished size. Artist assumes all risk of damage to art during transport and scanning.

6. Repeat Entries:

There is no limit on the number of pieces an artist may submit for the Contest (each an “Entry”). Artists are encouraged to submit a series that would fit the horizontal installation of tiles (2 – 4 images that are 12”x12” aligned left to right).

7. Judging Criteria:

- Adherence to Theme, Mood, and Palette; ○ Quality and command of the medium used; ○ Composition and design; ○ Creativity; ○ Impact.

8. Submission Deadlines:

Artworks may be submitted up until midnight Eastern Standard Time on July 1, 2020 (“Deadline”).

9. Age Requirement:

This Contest is open to all legal U.S. residents who are 18 years of age or older or those under 18 who have the express consent of a parent or guardian. Parents of minors must agree to sign any required releases which may be necessary.

10. The Work Must Be Original:

You must be the creator of the art and own all rights to the art. If your image infringes upon another's copyright it will be disqualified. Upon submitting your work, to this Contest, you are representing that you created the Entry and have the sole rights to use it and to grant us a license to use it. You are solely responsible for any infringement on copyrighted materials and will indemnify and hold the Organizers harmless from any and all claims of the same which may be asserted by third parties, including but not limited to the Organizers' reasonable attorney's fees incurred. The Organizers reserve the right to request proof that your Entry is your original artwork created solely by you.

11. Submission of Art:

There are no fees to submit art in this Contest. By submitting art into this Contest, you agree that you are eligible under Contest rules and that you abide by all Contest rules. The Organizers shall not be held responsible for damage done to the Entries submitted for the Contest at any time. The Organizers are not responsible for misdirected Entries which are not received prior to the Deadline. The Entries will not be returned to the artists. If you wish to claim your Entry after the Contest, you must retrieve it from the Wayne Center for the Arts after the conclusion of the Contest and any related Exhibits, or it will be destroyed.

12. Copyright:

The artist retains all copyrights to their artwork.

13. Non-exclusive Permissions:

By entering this Contest, you are granting us a non-exclusive, perpetual license to reproduce images of your artwork for public viewing and in promotional/informational materials used in the normal course of business of the Organizers, including but not limited to print and social media. You are also granting the Organizers permission to display the Entry in Exhibits to be held at the Wayne Center for the Arts through December 31, 2020. Dates of any Exhibits will be scheduled when restrictions on public gatherings have been lifted.

14. Winning Entries:

Up to 60 Entries will be selected and winners will be notified by July 22, 2020. Digital images of the winning Entries will be scanned in full color onto tiles that will be installed in seatwalls constructed by the City of Wooster along South Market Street. No other consideration will be given for winning Entries. Sponsorships will be solicited by the non-profit Organizers and any funds raised in excess of expenses will be divided equally between the Wayne Center for the Arts and Main Street Wooster, Inc.
