Removing barriers to the arts, WCA reaches over **7,000 youth** by working with agencies throughout Wayne County, such as Orrville Area Boys & Girls Club, YMCA, and Head Start preschools, bringing art into our community, and ensuring arts opportunities are available for everyone.
